

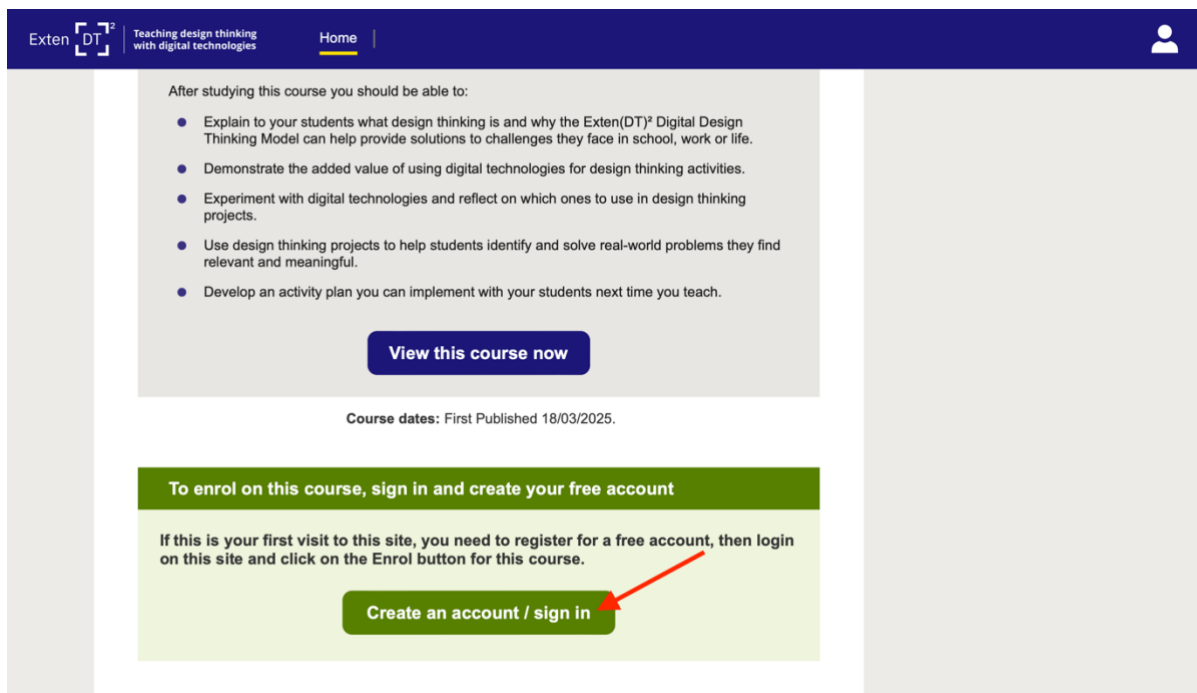
# Teaching Design Thinking with Digital Technologies: A free OpenLearn Create Course
